

ORDER CALLING A BOND ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR THE CONDUCT AND THE GIVING OF NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION; AND RESOLVING OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of the Laredo Independent School District (the "District"), located in Webb County, Texas (the "County") finds and determines that it is necessary and advisable to call and hold the election hereinafter ordered pursuant to Subchapter A, Chapter 45, Texas Education Code, and the Texas Election Code;

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to contract for election services with the Webb County Elections Office, as authorized by Section 31.092, Texas Election Code; and

WHEREAS, the District will contract with the Elections Administrator (the "Elections Administrator") of the County to conduct all aspects of the Election; and

WHEREAS, the Board hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the District to enter into an election agreement with the County to conduct the Election in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas (the "State") and applicable federal laws; and

WHEREAS, the Board hereby finds and determines that the actions herein described are in the best interests of the qualified voters of the District; now, therefore,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LAREDO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1. The statements contained in the preamble of this Order are true and correct and adopted as findings of fact.

Section 2. An election shall be held on May 5, 2018 ("Election Day"), in the District, at which election the following proposition shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION A

"Shall the Board of Trustees of the Laredo Independent School District be authorized to issue bonds of the District in the principal amount of not to exceed \$150,795,000 for the purposes of constructing, renovating, acquiring, and equipping school buildings in the District and the purchase of the necessary sites therefor, including improvements to Cigarroa High School, Cigarroa Middle School, the Nixon High School Vocational Building, the Nixon High School ROTC Building, the Nixon High School Athletic Weight Facility, Ligarde Elementary School, Dovalina Elementary School, and Kawas Elementary School, and also including completion of the Administration Building, such bonds to mature serially or otherwise in accordance with law; any issue or series of such bonds to bear interest per annum at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable, or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of the Board of Trustees, provided that such rate or rates of interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of such bonds; and shall the Board of Trustees be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed an collected, annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in the District sufficient, without limit at to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds and the cost of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?"

Section 3. In accordance with Section 3.009, Texas Election Code, the Board makes the following disclosures:

- (a) The proposition language is set forth in Section 2;
- (b) The purpose for which the Bonds are to be authorized is stated in Section 2;
- (c) The principal amount of the Bonds to be authorized is \$150,795,000;
- (d) Ad valorem taxes sufficient to pay the annual principal and interest on the Bonds may be imposed;
- (e) The maximum interest rate of the Bonds or any series of the Bonds is estimated to be 6.00%, based on the market conditions at the time of this Order. This estimated tax rate is derived from projections obtained from the District's financial advisor and is provided without any assurance that such projections will be realized. At the time that bonds are issued, the actual total tax rate will depend upon, among other factors, prevailing interest rates, the assessed value of real property in the District and general market conditions; and
- (f) The maximum maturity date of the Bonds shall not exceed 40 years.
- (g) The aggregate amount of the outstanding principal of the District's Interest and Sinking tax debt obligations as of the beginning of the District's fiscal year in which the Election is ordered, being the year ended August 31, 2018 (the "Fiscal Year") is \$223,032,226 and the aggregate amount of the outstanding principal of the District's maintenance tax debt obligations as of the beginning of the District's Fiscal Year is \$0.00.
- (h) The aggregate amount of the outstanding interest on Interest and Sinking tax debt obligations of the District as of the beginning of the Fiscal Year is \$94,693,253 and the aggregate amount of the outstanding interest on maintenance tax debt obligations of the District as of the beginning of the Fiscal Year is \$0.00.
- (i) The Interest and Sinking tax debt service tax rate for the District at the time the Election is ordered is \$0.3297 per \$100 valuation of the taxable property and the portion of the maintenance tax debt service tax rate for the District at the time the Election is ordered is \$1.04 per \$100 valuation of the taxable property.

The statements contained in these findings (i) are based on information available to the District on the date of adoption of this Election Order, including information derived from projections obtained from the District's financial advisor, (ii) necessarily consist of estimates and projections that are subject to change based on facts, circumstances and conditions at the time that bonds approved pursuant to this Election Order are issued and (iii) are not intended to give rise to a contract with the voters or limit the authority of the Board to issue bonds in accordance with other terms contained in this Election Order. Accordingly, actual tax rates, interest rates, maturity dates, aggregate outstanding indebtedness and interest on such debt will vary and will be established after the bonds are issued. To the extent of any conflict between this subsection and other terms of this Election Order, such other terms control.

Section 4. Voting shall take place on Election Day between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. at the regular voting precincts, at the polling places as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as if copied in full.

Section 5. At least 63 days prior to the scheduled Election Day, the President of the Board, the Superintendent of Schools, or the respective designees thereof, will identify and formally approve the appointment of the Presiding Judge, Alternate Presiding Judges, Election clerks, and all other election officials for the Election. The Presiding Judge shall appoint not less than 2 resident qualified voters of the District to act as clerks. The appointment of these clerks must include a person fluent in the Spanish language to serve as clerk to render oral aid in the Spanish language to any voter desiring such aid at the polls on Election Day. If the Presiding Judge appointed actually serves, the Alternate Presiding Judge shall serve as one of the clerks. In the absence of the Presiding Judge, the Alternate Presiding Judge shall perform the duties of the Presiding Judge of the election precinct.

The main early voting locations and respective times are designated in Exhibit B to this Order (which is incorporated herein by reference for all purposes). The Elections Administrator is hereby appointed as the Early Voting Clerk to conduct such early voting in the election. The Early Voting Clerk shall appoint the Deputy Early Voting Clerks.

Early Voting by mail shall be conducted, in addition to any other manner permitted by law, by making application for ballots with the Early Voting Clerk at 1110 Washington Street, Suite 103, Laredo, Texas 78040, which is hereby designated as a place at which Early Voting by mail be conducted.

An Early Voting Ballot Board is hereby established for the purpose of processing early voting results. The Election Administrator or his Designee is hereby appointed the Presiding Judge of the Early Voting Ballot Board. The Presiding Judge shall appoint not less than 2 resident qualified voters of the District to serve as members of the Early Voting Ballot Board.

Section 6. The official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code, so as to permit the electors to vote "For" or "Against" the aforesaid proposition, which shall be set forth substantially as follows:

PROPOSITION A

THE ISSUANCE OF \$150,795,000 OF LAREDO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT SCHOOL BUILDING BONDS FOR THE PURPOSES OF CONSTRUCTING, RENOVATING, ACQUIRING, AND EQUIPPING SCHOOL BUILDINGS IN THE DISTRICT AND THE PURCHASE OF THE NECESSARY SITES THEREFOR, INCLUDING IMPROVEMENTS TO CIGARROA HIGH SCHOOL, CIGARROA MIDDLE SCHOOL, THE NIXON HIGH SCHOOL VOCATIONAL BUILDING, THE NIXON HIGH SCHOOL ROTC BUILDING, THE NIXON HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC WEIGHT FACILITY, LIGARDE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, DOVALINA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AND KAWAS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AND ALSO INCLUDING COMPLETION OF THE ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, AND THE LEVYING OF A TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF

Section 7. Voting machines may be used in holding and conducting the Election on Election Day; provided, however, that if the use of voting machines is not practicable, then in that event, electronic voting devices may be used in conducting the Election on Election Day; provided however, in the event the use of such electronic voting devices is not practicable, the Election may be conducted on Election Day by the use of paper ballots. Voting machines, electronic voting devices, or paper ballots may be used for Early Voting by personal appearance. Paper ballots may be used for Early Voting by mail. The District shall also utilize a Central Counting Station (the "Station") as provided by Section 127.000, *et seq.*, Texas Election Code. The Elections Administrator is hereby appointed as the Manager and may appoint The Presiding Judge, The Tabulation Supervisor of the Station, and may appoint Station clerks and establish a written plan for the orderly operation of the Station in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code. Lastly, the District, Elections Administrator, or its agent, will publish notice and conduct instruction testing on the automatic tabulation equipment relating to the Station and conduct instruction for the officials and clerks for the Station in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code. The District will provide at least one accessible voting system in each polling place that complies with state and federal laws setting the requirements for voting systems that permit voters with physical disabilities to cast a secret ballot.

Section 8. All election materials including notice of the election, ballots, instruction cards, affidavits, and other forms which voters may be required to sign and all early voting materials shall be printed in both English and Spanish, or Spanish translations thereof, and/or other assistance shall be provided, as required by the Texas Election Code and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.

Section 9. All resident, qualified voters of the District shall be permitted to vote at the Election, and on Election Day, such voters shall vote at the designated polling places. The Election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code, except as modified by the provisions of the Texas Education Code, and as may be required by law.

Section 10. Notice of the Election shall be given by: (i) publishing a substantial copy of this Order, in English and Spanish, one time not earlier than the thirtieth day nor later than the tenth day prior to Election Day, in a newspaper published in the District, (ii) by posting a copy of this Order on the bulletin board used for posting notices of meetings of the District's Board of Trustees, not later than the 21st day prior to Election Day, (iii) in three public places in the boundaries of the District, not later than the 21st day prior to Election Day, (iv) during early voting by personal appearance, in a prominent location at each polling place, and (v) on Election Day, in a prominent location at each polling place. Notice of the Election shall also be provided to the County Clerk of Webb County, no later than the 60th day before Election Day.

Section 11. The Board authorizes the President, Board of Trustees, the Superintendent of Schools, or the respective designees thereof, to negotiate and enter into an election agreement or agreements with the County, through the Elections Administrator, in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code. Further, the Board authorizes the President, Board of Trustees, the Superintendent of Schools, or the respective designees thereof, including bond counsel for the District, to make technical modifications to this Order that are necessary for compliance with applicable Texas or federal law or to carry out the intent of the Board.

Section 12. The recitals contained in the preamble hereof are found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made part of this Order for all purposes and are adopted as part of the judgment and findings of the Board.

Section 13. All orders and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Order are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Order shall be and remain controlling as to the matters ordered herein.

Section 14. This Order shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.

Section 15. If any provision of this Order or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Order and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the Board hereby declares that this Order would have been enacted without such valid provision.

Section 16. It is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this Order is adopted was open to the public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Order, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.

Section 17. This Order shall be in force and effect from and after its final passage, and it is so ordered.
