| Loss or Damage: | Loss, theft or any structural damage of the laptop must be reported to the District no later than the next school day after the occurrence. If the incident occurred outside of District property, a police report must be turned in to the District as soon as it becomes available. | Repossession: | Failure to comply with all terms of this Agreement and the Parent/Student Laptop Handbook, including the timely return of the laptop as designated the District, will result in the District using reasonable means to attempt recovery of the laptop. | | | |
| Term of Agreement: | The right to use and possession of the laptop terminates no later than the date designated by District for the school year unless otherwise terminated by the District or upon withdrawal from the District. | | | |
